CLASS A UNIFORM

The Scout uniform emphasizes unity while diminishing the importance of a person's financial, social and ethnic background. Additionally, it is an instantly recognized backdrop for clearly showing each individual's Scouting accomplishments. Troop 405 requires members to properly wear their Class A uniform for the first troop meeting of each month, whenever we travel to and from a campout, Court of Honor, Rank Advancement and whenever we will be in the public eye. Troop 405 recognizes that the first year scouts grow rather fast, so we have two sets of guidelines for the Class A's. ***** Uniforms must be maintained with all current patches, leadership positions and rank, etc*****

New Scout to Second Class

- Khaki BSA shirt
- Can wear Blue Jeans/or Khaki School Pants
- Neckerchief & Slide
- Scout Belt
- Closed Toe Shoes –Hiking Boots not required, other examples, School Shoes or Clean tennis shoes
- Scout Socks – Not Required
- Sash – Not Required
- Hat is optional

Rank of First Class and Above

- Khaki BSA shirt
- Olive Green pants or shorts
- Neckerchief & Slide
- Scout Belt
- Scout Socks
- Closed Toe Shoes or Hiking Boots
- Hat is optional
- Sash – Troop 405 will only require the sash to be worn at Rank Advancements, Court of Honor, Parades, or other formal events due to wanting to preserve the sash with all the merit badges.

CLASS B UNIFORM

The Class B uniform is the Troop 405 Red Polo Shirt and can be purchased through the troop for \$15.00. Either the Class B or the Class C should be worn during troop activities and to troop meetings with the exception of the 1st Troop Meeting. The Class C Shirt could also be worn whenever the Class B is required. The Class B or the Class C should be worn to the can drives.

CLASS C UNIFORM

The Class C uniform is the Troop 405 Red T-shirt and can be purchased through the troop for \$10.00. This can be worn whenever the Class B is required. See Class B Uniform
